# Edelgard Fernandez Mejia (State Representative 19B Candidate)

- My full name is Edelgard Fernandez Mejia. I am 50 years old and the father of three (20, 16 and 13).
- I was born in Guanajuato, Mexico and have a bachelor's degree in communications and public relations from Universidad Santa Fe. I moved to Minnesota in 2000 and worked in Wilmar as a Migrant Labor Representative. A few years later, I was hired as the Director of Multicultural Affairs and Head Soccer Coach at Ridgewater College (I received a scholarship to earn an Advanced National Coaching License from the United States Soccer Coaches Association).
- I moved to Owatonna in 2013 to work at Riverland Community College as a Multicultural Enrollment Advisor and the Head Soccer Coach. My current position is Director of Admissions at South Central College splitting time between campuses in Faribault and North Mankato.
- My involvement with the community includes being a member of the Board of Directors for the Owatonna Public Library, Owatonna Soccer Association, Big Brothers Big Sisters Board and I am a Rotarian. I am a graduate of the Owatonna Chamber of Commerce Leadership Program and am active with several of United Way's initiatives, as well as the former "CultureFest" Organization. I have served as a soccer coach and referee and have continued to organize the Youth Soccer Program for Owatonna Parks and Recreation every Spring.
- Having become a United States Citizen I have experienced what it is like coming to a new country and the importance of having and gaining the skills and education to be able to contribute to your community.
